The mission and responsibility of BSA is to introduce and instruct them in the heritage and exercise of these wholesome pursuits.

During the 2015 elections, Charles Glackin decided not to run for President of the club. After many years of dedicated service, Charlie decided it was time to hand over the reins. After a few months with the President position vacant, John Moll stepped up and took over the duties and responsibility of President. In June, Brandon Frederick accepted the nomination of Acting Vice President. Brandon's zeal and eagerness to serve the club is very much appreciated.

2015 was a productive year for BSA:

- Member Richard Brennan donated a magnet for steel casing pickup at the range. Richard also donated a new steel plate target for the 145 made of AR500 steel.
- The pond garage was improved with a concrete floor and a new garage door.
- A walking archery target path was built including 3D targets.
- Rifle range backstops have been repaired.
